Swimming

It is unfortunate that swimming lessons have been impacted by the shortage of instructors at Midland Swimming Centre but thanks to the work of school staff and some financial support from the Education department we have been able to arrange additional transport, at no extra cost to families. The school has no control over the staff shortages at the pool and we appreciate your support and understanding around this. Swimming will be held over the next two weeks with half the school participating in Week 5 and the second half in week 6. It is disappointing that we have been reduced to only 5 x 40-minute sessions but it is still an excellent opportunity for your children. The information below has been sent home today in preparation for next week's sessions.

Dear Parents and carers,

Just a follow up note from the notice put on Connect, we have been able to secure additional buses to assist with the transportation of students to and from their lessons now that they are only staying at the pools for 1 x 40-minute lesson (total of 5 lessons over the week), and only one class able to attend at one time. The Department will cover this additional cost of transportation so that parents are not impacted.
