


AFL SPECIALIST PROGRAM

The program is endorsed by the East Perth Football Club in collaboration with the Western Australian Football Commission.





From 9 December, the Ellenbrook Line will open, introducing five new stations to the network: Ellenbrook, Whiteman Park, Ballajura, Noranda and Morley.

To coincide with the opening of the METRONET Ellenbrook Line, there will be significant changes to the Transperth bus network in Perth's north and northeastern suburbs.

These changes will impact how your child travels to school and some journeys will now include a train, with bus services designed to feed into the new train stations.

Top tip

If you're travelling within the same zone, it won't cost you any more.

We encourage all students to use the Transperth JourneyPlanner before 9 December. Remember to change the date to your day of travel!
