Brazilian Jiu Jitsu World Championships



Ellenbrook Primary School congratulates Jarrah Blackmore on his outstanding achievement at the World Youth Jiu-Jitsu Championships in Abu Dhabi!

Jarrah proudly represented our school and community on the world stage, placing 9th in the world in a division of 70 competitors from across the globe!

This incredible event brought together over 10,000 competitors from 130 countries, with approximately 30,000 spectators across 10 days. It was broadcast live worldwide and shown nationally on TV in the UAE. Back home, the Ellenbrook Primary community cheered loudly for Jarrah—we're sure he could hear us all the way from Abu Dhabi!

Jarrah and his family described the event as intimidating yet unforgettable—the size, the noise, and the sheer energy made it the most intense competition they've ever experienced.

Jarrah travelled as part of the Perth Martial Arts Centre team (Ellenbrook and Malaga), which took 11 children (ages 7–13) and 4 adults to compete. Their results were exceptional, with all competitors placing in the Top 10, including 4 World Champions, 1 second place, and 1 third place. This incredible performance highlights the club as one of the strongest and highest-achieving martial arts centres in Western Australia—if not Australia.

As a school community, we congratulate Jarrah and celebrate his remarkable achievement. We are incredibly proud of you! 😊
